This letter is to commend the work conducted by the Institute for Law and Policy Planning (ILPP) on behalf of the California Student Aid Commission.

ILPP completed a general facility plan for the Commission in March 1992. This facility plan analyzes the Commission's future space requirements and provides cost-effective recommendations for housing the Commission's operations over the next 15-20 years. It identifies building ownership options which could save the Commission from \$9 million to \$25 million over a 20-year period.

The content and quality of the work completed by ILPP met all of the Commission's expectations. The firm carefully examined our complex operations and developed a thorough understanding of facility needs over the next decade and beyond. They accommodated our design needs, demonstrated flexibility in responding to requests for special analyses, and proved able to meet required timelines.
