Some years ago, I had the privilege of taking a training course from you at the UC Extension facility in Richmond. It was your course on crisis intervention, focusing on the obtaining and transmission of vital information after critical incidents, such as rapes and robberies. After 23 years on the job, it remains, to date, the finest training course I ever experienced.
