Although I haven't looked today the DCYC population has been averaging 125 to 135 as compared to 217 one year ago. The HOME program (electronic monitoring) has gone from 35 to 55 participants. The Juvenile Justice Council meets monthly and on this Wednesday, State Probation will discuss their proposed retooling of juvenile probation and introduce a new intake tool. Legislation is being introduced to reform the juvenile code, although I have not seen the draft legislation.
