Dr. Kalmanoff has been retained by Leon County to study and make recommendations in our criminal justice system as it relates to the flow of cases through the court system and the overcrowding of our local county jail.


Dr. Kalmanoff has completed all of the projects on time and I am not aware of any exceeding of the budget on expenses. Dr. Kalmanoff has given many positive changes and we are at present time attempting to adopt and implement many of those suggestions as they would fit in our criminal justice system in the present courthouse facility. We are about to move into a new justice facility and I am certain that many of the suggestions made by Dr. Kalmanoff will be implemented when we have more room. I am unaware of any local official who has not readily accepted his recommendations and everyone has been cooperative in our joint effort to relieve overcrowding and making the justice system more responsive to our needs.

I am unaware of the fees paid to Dr. Kalmanoff by the county and would refer this to Commissioner Bill Montford for his response to your question number five.
